

Make Your Own City

with

Description:

Join artist Hamish Pearch to create your own 3D paper city. Using Hamish's printouts, you'll design and construct buildings by transforming flat shapes into dynamic, free-standing structures. Through cutting, gluing, and assembling, you'll create a growing cityscape. With three difficulty levels to choose from, you can experiment with different shapes and designs. Use colour and collage as you explore the relationship between the natural and the man-made.

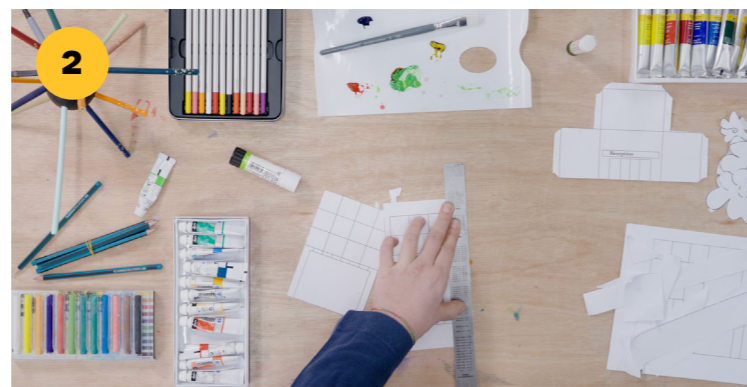
You will need:

- Paper printouts - available on the Hospital Rooms website
- A ruler
- A glue stick

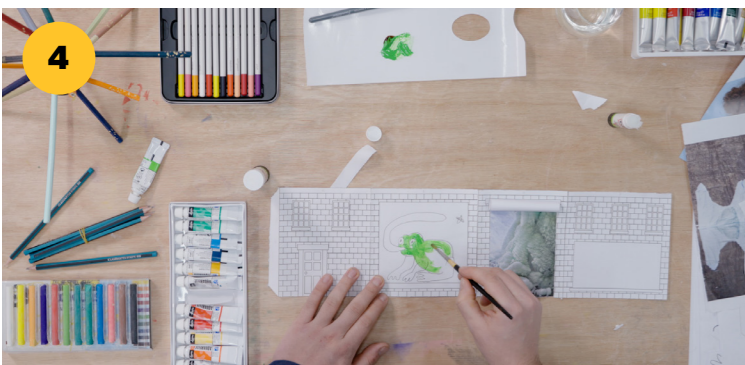
1 Gather printouts and materials. Decide which structure you would like to make. A house, a water-tower, a hotel or a barn.



2 Cut out the pieces from the template - either using scissors or tear with a ruler like Hamish.



3 Matching the letters (A-A, B-B etc), line up each piece and glue together so you have connected the flat panels.



4 Now think about what you want your building to look like. You can collage, paint and draw different designs onto the printed out pieces.



5 Next match the remaining letters together creating a 3D structure. Glue the final pieces like the roof which will add support and allow the building to stand on its own.



6 You can now choose to cut out and stick on the flowers and mushrooms from the print outs Hamish has designed or add your own unique finishing touches.



Now you have your completed building you can make another and gradually add to your own expanding city!
